HOW TO USE THE FOF

Do stray and feral cats tug at your heartstrings?

Then use our program...
It's as easy as 1, 2, 3.

- 1 Call our hotline—510-433-9446. We'll call you back!! To reserve space for you at our next clinic, AND direct you to our nearest trap depot, so you can borrow humane traps.
- 2 Prepare a safe enclosed place where the cats can stay to recover from surgery. We'll show you how to trap them the night before the clinic.
- 3 Clinic Day: Drop off the cats in the morning; pick them up the same afternoon. After they recover, release them and continue to care for them.

Wonderful things happen when we spay and neuter homeless cats... using Trap-Neuter-Return (T-N-R). You and your neighbors will love the results!

Here's why:

- You'll sleep better—no more fighting and midnight yowling.
- Your heart won't be broken—no more litters of unwanted kittens.

And

- The cats you sterilize will help keep new unneutered cats away.
- You'll still have free rodent control.
- And, best yet, with no more breeding, the number of cats will keep on decreasing!
- T-N-R is the ONLY way to permanently reduce the cat population.
